

IDENTITY CHECK REQUIREMENTS FOR HIGH VALUE RENTAL PROPERTIES

What do we need?

As required by legislation, we need to complete identity checks on all parties involved in high value rentals of a property. Please therefore provide one document from each of the following lists for yourself:

List A - Verification of identity	List B - Verification of your current residential address
 A valid Passport (any nationality) A valid UK Photocard Driving Licence 	This document needs to clearly show your name (same as per the document under List A) and full residential address wherever it is in the world.
	Household utility bill. This could be: gas, electricity, water, landline, satellite TV, TV licence or service charge/ground rent invoice with an issue date within the last three months
	Bank or Building society statement with an issue date within the last three months
	Solicitors letter confirming recent house purchase dated within the last three months
	Mortgage statement from a recognised lender issued within the last year
	Local Authority council tax bill for the <u>current</u> <u>council tax year</u>
	Council or housing association rent card or tenancy agreement for the current year
	HMRC self-assessment letters or tax demand dated within the current financial year
	We <u>cannot</u> accept
	A mobile phone bill
	A credit card statement

If we haven't met you

If we haven't met you, we need both of the documents to be certified - The certifier must have met you, so they can confirm the photo is a true likeness.

The certifier (see below who can certify) needs to include the following statement on each document:

- Photo ID (List A document) "Certified to be a true copy of the original seen by me and the photograph
 is a true likeness of the individual whom I have met"
- Proof of Address (List B Document) "Certified to be a true copy of the original seen by me"

They also need to:

- Sign and date the documents
- Identify who they are, including their profession, membership number (If applicable), work address and telephone number

The following people can certify a document

- Bank/Building Society Official (must be stamped with branch stamp)
- Chartered Accountant

- Doctor/Dentist
- Notary

- Solicitor
- Teacher/Lecturer
